The position is on a rotation basis in a remote site North of Pemberton/ West of Lillooet.

Key Responsibilities

- Measure and collect core recovery and RQD (Rock Quality Designation) data
- Conduct fracture counts and measure depth intervals
- Piece together broken drill core and draw orientation lines
- Move and organize core boxes in core shacks and storage areas
- Cut core using a diamond blade saw according to sampling protocol
- Conduct point load tests on core to assist in rock strength calculations
- Clean and maintain core logging and sampling areas
- Assist geologists and geological students as needed

Qualifications

- Excellent basic math skills
- Physically capable of lifting and moving heavy core boxes (up to ~50 lbs)

- Comfortable working in outdoor and remote conditions
 - Proficient with Microsoft Office (Excel, Word, Outlook)
 - Strong time management, communication, and organizational skills
 - Valid Class 5 driver's license (or equivalent)
 - Previous field or industry experience is an asset but not required
 - Must be comfortable working in a remote camp setting for extended periods
 - Eligible to work in Canada (does not require sponsorship)
