The position is based in Bralorne, British Columbia. The successful candidate will work on a rotational schedule. Relocation package is available to Lillooet and surrounding area.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Manages the human, financial, and operational resources at Bralorne Gold and Ladner Mines;
- Formulates the annual operating and capital budgets for operations, consistent with Talisker's established financial guidelines and business planning process;
- Oversee the health and safety of site operations including underground activities;
- Oversee the Camp Maintenance and manage the catering & Camp services at Bralorne.
- Oversees the implementation of processes, policies, systems, and practices within operations that maximize operational efficiencies;
- Lead and manage the operations team responsible for supporting the Geology team in executing Talisker's exploration strategy;
- Develops policies and standard operating procedures relating to safety, the environment and individual;
- Ensures that direct reports and respective work areas are in compliance with Health and Safety policies and Environmental regulations;
- Ensures direct reports have the necessary training, skills, knowledge, and tools to do their jobs safely;

- Lead on accident and incident investigations and ensures that recommendations are implemented;
